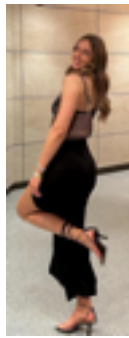
PURPLE VICE CAPTAIN:

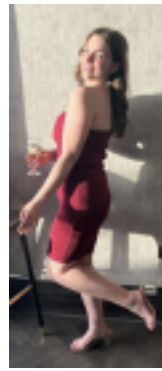

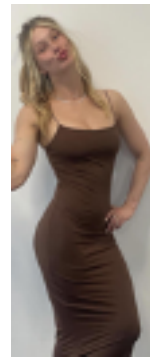

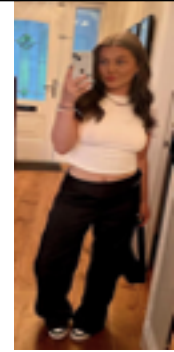

Why Carnegie?

At Carnegie Cheer we have two competitive cheer teams. Black is level 3 tumbling, Purple is level 2 non-tumbling. Both teams train alongside and are apart of the Aviators Cheerleading programme.

*All merch is optional to each individual so prices may vary (excludes uniform, bow, and training tops which are compulsory.)

Prices are based upon last year's expenses but are subject to change for the 23/24 season depending on sponsorships and alumni.

Athlete Guidelines (A code of conduct will be emailed to you prior to you accepting your place which must be signed)

Athletes are representatives of Carnegie cheer and Leeds Beckett University in and out of uniform so will be expected to behave to the highest standard of moral conduct.

- Cheerleading can be a dangerous sport, so under NO circumstances should an athlete be under the influence of drugs or alcohol during training/competition. If this is the case the athlete will be terminated from the team immediately by coaches whose decision is final . This does not mean that being part of the competition team you cannot drink. It's just that we ask for your safety you are fully aware and in sound mind at training and competitions.

- **ATTENDANCE IS THE KEY TO SUCCESS:** All training and competition dates are mandatory unless stated at the start of the season or otherwise authorised. Unauthorised absences may jeopardise your place on the team. We also operate a no absence policy two weeks prior to competitions. Missing these sessions could result in being moved out of a stunt group or tumble in the routine or cut completely. All decisions are those of the coaches and their decisions are final.

- Sportsman like conduct to be upheld at all times

- Respect to be given to coaches, committee members and all other athletes, bullying **WILL NOT** be tolerated under any circumstances.

- All fees are non-refundable and **MUST** be paid on time. Failure of this will result in increased prices for everyone and potentially withdrawal from a competition.

- **INJURIES:** If you are injured or unwell, we still expect you to come to training and sit at the front. However, we understand that under certain circumstances this is not possible, but we ask you try your best to always be at training. We are a team.

- If you have any questions, please message a member of the committee and **NOT** your coaches.
